## OUR APPOINTMENT POLICY

You may make an appointment either by calling us on **0203 627 3060**, emailing the practice at [Plumstead@pds-health.co.uk](mailto:Plumstead@pds-health.co.uk) or by visiting the Practice during the opening hours and arranging the time and date with the receptionist.

Here at PDS, we want to offer as many appointments as possible to those who really need them.

Please help us to give the best service possible by giving us 24 hour notice if you need to cancel your appointment.

Failure to cancel an appointment or in case of late notice of cancellation on two or more occasions, may result in a patient being removed from our patient list.

## OUR EMERGENCY APPOINTMENTS

We always try to see emergency patients on the same day and usually within 24 hours. This service is provided within our ordinary opening hours, 5 days a week, throughout the year excluding Public Holidays.

In order to find out when our emergency slots are that day, and what is the approximate waiting time, please phone us on **0203 627 3060** as early as possible in the day.

The priority during an emergency appointment is immediate pain relief. This falls under a Band 4 NHS treatment and costs accordingly. Further treatment may be necessary at a later appointment and will be charged according to the NHS' banded prices.

## OUT OF HOURS SERVICE

For out-of-hours emergency services, please call NHS Direct on **111**. You will then be directed appropriately.

## OUR RECALLS OR CHECK-UP POLICY

Your dentist will recommend a date for your next visit and discuss this with you. You may find out that your next check-up is as short as 3 months or as long as 2 years. It all depends on how healthy your teeth and gums are and your risk of future problems .

Recalls or check-ups do not stop you from attending the Practice in case of emergency requirements. If you have problems with your teeth between check-ups, contact the reception for an appointment.

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## OUR DENTAL FEES

NHS prices for fee paying patients are set annually by the government. A written estimate/treatment plan will be provided following your initial consultation and before your treatment but be aware that this may change as time progresses.

Treatment that is not clinically necessary will be made available to patients who request it on a private basis, for example white crowns fitted on molars. A written statement will be given after the initial consultation.

## NHS PRICE LIST FROM 1<sup>st</sup> APRIL 2016

### Band 1. Diagnosis, treatment planning and maintenance

Clinical examination, radiographs, scale and polishing by dentist, preventive work: e.g. oral health assessment, study models, denture bases.

### Band 2. Treatment

Simple treatment e.g. fillings including root canal treatment, extractions, surgical procedures and dental additions, periodontal treatment.

**£53.90**

### Band 3. Provision of appliances

Complex treatment that includes a laboratory element: e.g. crowns and dentures, includes mouth guards.

**£233.70**

### Band 4. Urgent treatment (emergencies only)

Assessment, radiographs, dressings. One of the following:- Re-cementing crowns, up to two extractions if possible (if no infection) and one filling.
